Black on Grey Field Rathaus with Double-Headed Bat Displayed in Oval Frame Above Bordered by 10 BIZOT White in Scalloped Grey Frame Dexter and Sinister Chief BAD BLINTZ Grey POST OFFICE White Base Rattus Sapiens Curved White Symbol of Envelope Bordered by Rat and Man Dexter and Sinister. The stamps were printed and perforated by BDT International Security Printing in Ireland using perforating drums rather than a linear perforator. Designed by David Wyatt
