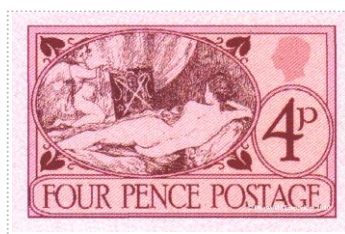


Issued in the Year of the Three Roses

Plum on a Goose-Pimpled Pink Field Seamstress Couchant Dishabite Looking at Guild Coat of Arms supported by Cherub in Oval Frame Bounded by Leaves
Sinister Patrician Profile Dexter above 4p in Oval Frame Base FOUR PENCE POSTAGE in Curved Frame.
