The first DISCWORLD JAMBOREE will be held just outside the town of Wincanton in Somerset.

The site itself is a lovely collection of playing fields girdled with old hedgerows and trees. The Site has a large sports pavilion which will be ours for the weekend.

It has showers, changing rooms, toilets, a bar, a first aid room, and a dining area. In fact everything we need as a nucleus for hosting such a special event.

Not only will we have use of the sports centre, we will have at least 3 huge marquees, each measuring 100ft x 20ft; sufficient space to house 600 or more people if the weather is inclement. There will be a security service in operation throughout the day and night.

Catering will be provided from the early morning to supper and all stages in between. There will be Freshly cooked food using local produce, catering for vegetarians, carnivores, and children.

Also there will be a beer tent run by CAMRA which guarantees the quality of the ales & ciders on offer, and not at London prices either. Soft drinks will be available, wine, and icecreams, in fact everything we can think of to make this the best Discworld Weekend you have ever experienced.

There will be classes in this ancient art, and you can learn all about the way the bow was used in war and hunting. This will be a badge event.


