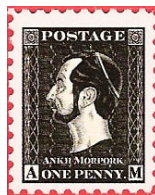

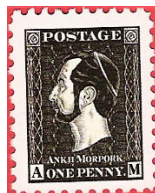
Mostly black showing the profile of Lord Havelock Vetinari.

Charcoal hues over a steel grey background. Morporkia girdled, fork in ascent, with the Ankh-Morpork coat of arms on a shield.

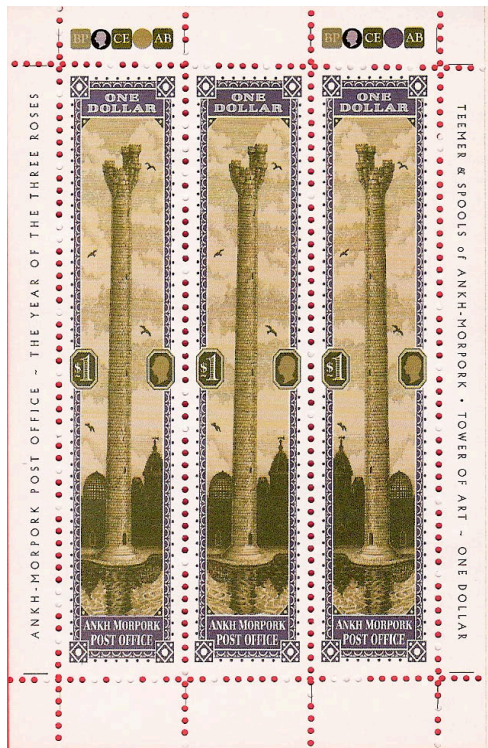

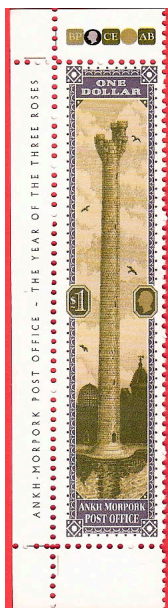

Only the reflection is shown reversed in the water.



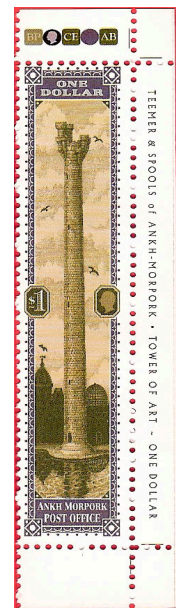
Common Sport

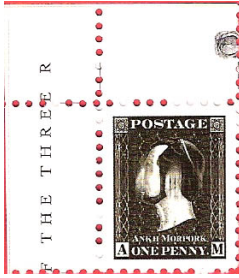

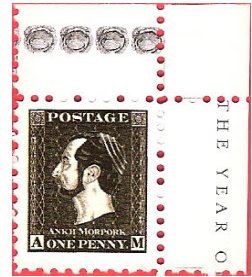


Cartouche Sport

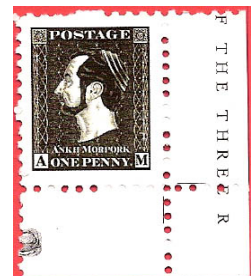
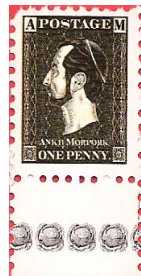
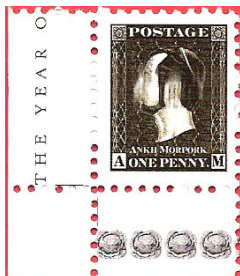


Racing Colours

Klatch 10 Wol

Introducing a new stamp from the Klatch Revenue service, featuring the phoenix rising from the flames. The stamp is in shades of marine blue.

Klatch 50 Wol

An impressive new stamp from the Klatch Revenue service. In various shades of sage and mint green and buff, featuring the phoenix rising from the flames.

As above, except that the licks of flame at the bottom of the stamp have been altered.

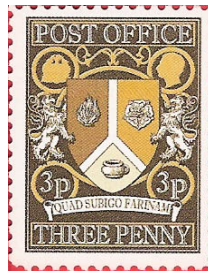


Guild of Heralds 3p

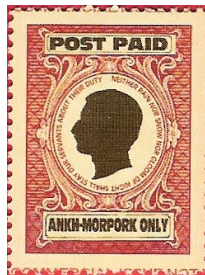


Ankh-Morpork Post Paid

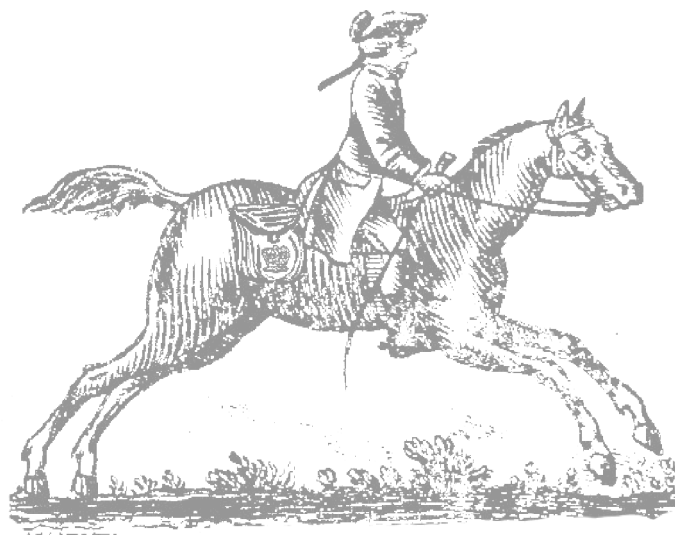


Lorenzo I Tribute

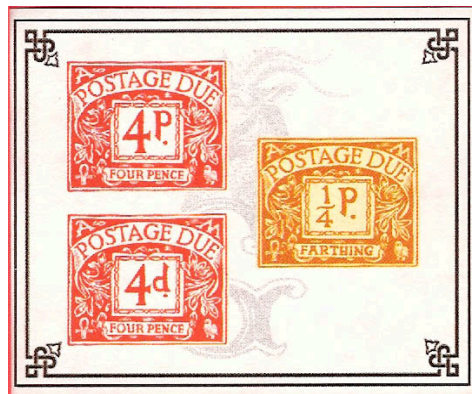
